We look forward to your upcoming visit at the Southwest Fort Worth Endoscopy Center. It is the policy of the Southwest Fort Worth Endoscopy Center to notify you of the following information prior to your arrival at the facility:

3. [Facility policy regarding Advance Directives](#):
 - A. You have the right to make choices regarding life-sustaining treatment, including resuscitative measures.
 - B. It is the policy of the Southwest Fort Worth Endoscopy Center that if an adverse event occurs during a patient's stay, based on reasons of conscience, all reasonable efforts will be taken to revive the patient, including resuscitative or other stabilizing measures, regardless of the contents of any Advance Directive/Living Will/Healthcare Proxy, or instructions from a healthcare agent. If there is a need to transfer you to a hospital for additional care measures beyond what the ambulatory facility can provide, your Advance Directive/Living Will/Healthcare Proxy, will be provided to the receiving hospital.
 - C. If you have an Advance Directive/Living Will/Healthcare Proxy, please bring a copy with you so we may place it with your medical record.
 - D. If you do not have an Advance Directive/Living Will/Healthcare Proxy, and would like more information, please contact our office at 817-423-2888 and we will be happy to assist you. You may also visit www.caringinfo.org or call 800-658-8898 for state-specific advance directive laws and forms.
